Olympic Committee of Kosovo

The Olympic Committee of Kosovo was officially established in 1992. In 2016 Kosovo became the 205th full member of the International Olympic Committee, a step that enabled Kosovar athletes to participate in the Rio 2016 Olympic Games.

Kosovo made its Olympic debut as a member state in 2016. Winning its first medal on its debut appearance, when judoka Majlinda Kelmendi took gold in the women's -52 kg category.

Methodology

The media monitoring methodology is conducted in two industry standards and formats. At first, Republika Communications Agency has initiated the automated media monitoring service, an automated software that monitors keywords according to the client's request and interest for media coverage, selected countries and continents, in different languages and areas of interest.

As a second method for verifying the collected data, manual monitoring has been conducted to legitimize the content extracted automatically. After the end of the monitoring period, the agency team issued reports with defined performance indicators, to enable the creation of the final report.

Please note that the report does not include Serbian media nor Cyrillic, Mandarin and Arabic content - in which media articles and mentions have been generated.







Prize for an individual gold medal: 100,000 euros (\$119,000)

The government of tiny Kosovo is paying 100,000 euros to gold medalists, 60,000 to silver medalists and 40,000 to bronze medalists, with two Olympic champions (judokas Nora Gjakova and Distria Krasniqi) in Tokyo already. Olympic coaches can win half as much—50,000, 30,000 or 20,000 euros—for their athletes' performances. In addition, the Kosovo Olympic committee plans to offer its own reward to the gold medalists, with the sum still being decided, a committee official tells *Forbes*.



Judoka Nora Gjakova wins gold on mourning day for Kosovo

PRISTINA, Kosovo (AP) — Nora Gjakova brought some semblance of joy to Kosovo by winning its second Tokyo Olympics judo gold medal on Monday.

With her country in mourning following the death of 10 people in a road accident on Sunday, the 28-year-old Gjakova took the title with an ippon victory over France's Sarah-Leonie Cysique in the women's 57-kilogram division.

She joined Distria Krasniqi, who took the 48kg crown on Saturday, as the second and third gold medalists in Kosovo's Olympic history. Majlinda Kelmendi won the first at Rio de Janeiro in 2016, also in judo.

"On this mourning day for our people, Nora Gjakova brought light to Kosovo," President Vjosa Osmani posted on Facebook upon returning from Japan after cutting short her trip due to the accident.






Caroline Dubois and Pat McCormack battle through first Olympic fights at Tokyo 2020 but Cheavon Clarke is out





Topics Reach








Publications per region


Most publications were in Kosovo. Kosovo more than 1000 followed by Albania with more than 250 publications and Macedonia with more than 40 publications




Publications per portal






Tokyo 2020 Olympics have generated many publications in various international media, including A-listers, such as the BBC, Forbes, Bloomberg, Associated Press, EuroSport, Sky Sport, The Guardian and other media, the value of which is very high to international audiences around the world.

Overall, for the selected keywords monitored during the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games, 820+ articles have been written and published for Kosovo and its Olympic Team in the international media and hundreds more in the local and Southeast European media.

Considering the number of publications in all media and the average price of their advertising space, the average price for such a publication in prestigious international media has turned out to be at minimum 10,000 EUR on average.

This amount is multiplied by 820+ published articles, the total value of PAV for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games turns out to be over 8.2 million EUR for Kosovo Olympics Committee.

This value does not take into account publications in local and international media, the value of which per publication is on average EUR 550 per publication.

When the PAV of 8.2M EUR is added to the publications made by the regional media and the viral impact that the Olympic medals have had on social networks, then the total amount of PAV is considered way over 8.2M EUR.

With the modest approach to the PAV calculation and our tendency to avoid the margin of error in every calculation, the value to be published by KOK it is recommended to stay in the area of 8.2M, without monetizing 400M organic impressions generated in social media networks in dozens of countries, around the world.
