Re: 2025-2026 Dream Together Master Programme – Seoul National University

Dear Colleagues,

ANOC has greatly valued its partnership with the Seoul National University (SNU) since 2015, which has enabled ANOC to nominate over 40 students from the NOCs to participate in the esteemed Dream Together Master programme. This full scholarship graduate programme, funded by the Korean Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism (MCST) and the Korea Sports Promotion Foundation (KSPO), aims to strengthen international sports cooperation through global networking, as well as the provision of in-depth insight into the area of sport management, serving as a way of preparation for leadership positions in sport fields.

In line with our agreement with the Seoul National University, ANOC is pleased to open the nomination process for the 2025-2026 intake for NOCs. This year, we will have the opportunity to nominate 10 sports administrators who will significantly benefit from the academic and international experience. Any administrator with a higher education qualification (Bachelor's degree or higher) and English proficiency is eligible to participate.

The Dream Together Master is operated within the Global Sport Management Graduate Programme at the Seoul National University. Scheduled to run from late August 2025 to June 2027, participants will spend 17 months in the Republic of Korea until December 2026, followed by 6 months dedicated to thesis work in their home countries.

All required application documents, as outlined in the checklist attached, must be submitted **via email only to ANOC before the deadline of 15th March 2025**. Please note that applications submitted directly to the University will not be considered for ANOC scholarships. We kindly ask you to respect the application deadline and submit all the documents to ANOC for final decision (no delays will be accepted).

Following the application deadline in March, ANOC will announce the nominated candidates for the programme. Selected applicants must then submit hard copies of their documents directly to the University and complete the selection process with an interview with the University. The ANOC Office remains available should you have any questions regarding this scholarship programme.
